Occupational Health and Safety Legislation

- Risk assessment is required by law. The three main criteria of OH&S Legislative requirements are:
 1. Risk Assessment
 2. Consultation
 3. Implement controls
- The Legislation and the Australian Standard references e.g. AS 4360 & 2865

Theory of the Risk Assessment process

- Hazard identification, risk assessment and control
- Workplace hazards
- Principles of Risk assessment
- Hierarchy of Controls

Practical Risk Assessment exercise (requires access to suitable workplace or simulated worksite)

- Identification of actual hazards based on work procedures
- Determining the expected risk related to identified hazards.
- Using risk assessment tables (as per system employed by the client company) assess the risks.
- Develop appropriate controls
